

DATE	FRANK SIEFKAS' TIMELINE
1831 - 1833	Frank is born somewhere around the Engerhafe, Ostfriesland, Germany area
December 1849	Frank and his family board the Ship, Columbia, at the port of Bremen, Germany.
January 12, 1850	Frank and his family arrive at the port of New Orleans.
January/February 1850	Frank and his family settle in Tazewell County, Illinois
February 13, 1850	Frank's father, Albert, and older brother purchase land from a Harmon Monk.
August 22, 1850	Frank and his family is enumerated in the 1850 Tazewell County, Illinois census.
June 30, 1854	Frank's future wife, Etta Todden, and her family arrive at the port of New Orleans.
August 15, 1854	Frank's future father-in-law, Remington Todden, purchases land from a John Neivar in Pekin, Tazewell, Illinois.
November 18, 1854	Frank's father, Albert, purchases land in Pekin, Tazewell, Illinois.
Mid-Late 1854	The Siefkes family and the Todden family meet in Pekin, Tazewell, Illinois.
March 31, 1855	Frank Siefkes and EttaTodden are married in Tazewell County, Illinois. Probably Pekin, Illinois.
July 25, 1857	Frank and Etta's first son, Albert, is born in Woodford County, Illinois.
September 2, 1857	Frank and his younger brother, Jacob, purchase land in Woodford County, Illinois.
May 28, 1859	Frank purchases land in Livingston County, Illinois.
August 1860	Frank, Etta, and their son, Albert, is enumerated in the 1860 Livingston County, Illinois census.
December 2, 1863	Frank and Etta's second son, Remington, is born in Quincy, Adams, Illinois.
February 16, 1867	Frank and Etta's third son, Engelbert, is born in Sweethome, Nodaway, Missouri.
May 22, 1870	Frank and etta's fourth son, William, is born in Sweethome, Nodaway, Missouri.
June 1870	Frank's family is enumerated in the 1870 Nodaway County, Missouri census.
September 20, 1872	Frank and Etta's fifth son, Jacob, is born in Doyle, Clarke, Iowa.
June 29, 1874	Frank and Etta's sixth son, John, is born in Doyle, Clarke, Iowa.
August 27, 1896	Frank makes out his Last Will and Testament.
September 11, 1896	Frank passes away at his home in Doyle, Clarke, Iowa.
September 12, 1896	Frank is laid to rest at the Lacelle cemetery in Clarke County, Iowa.
